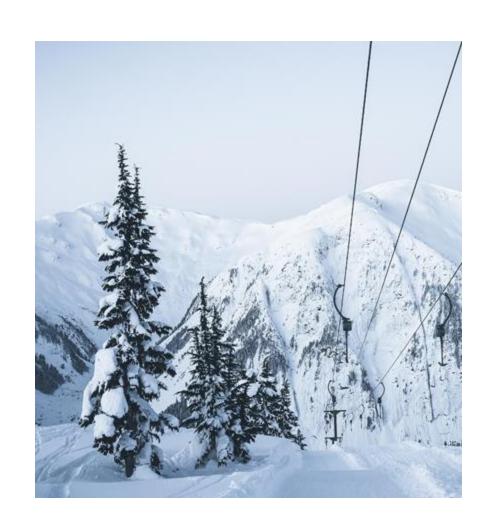

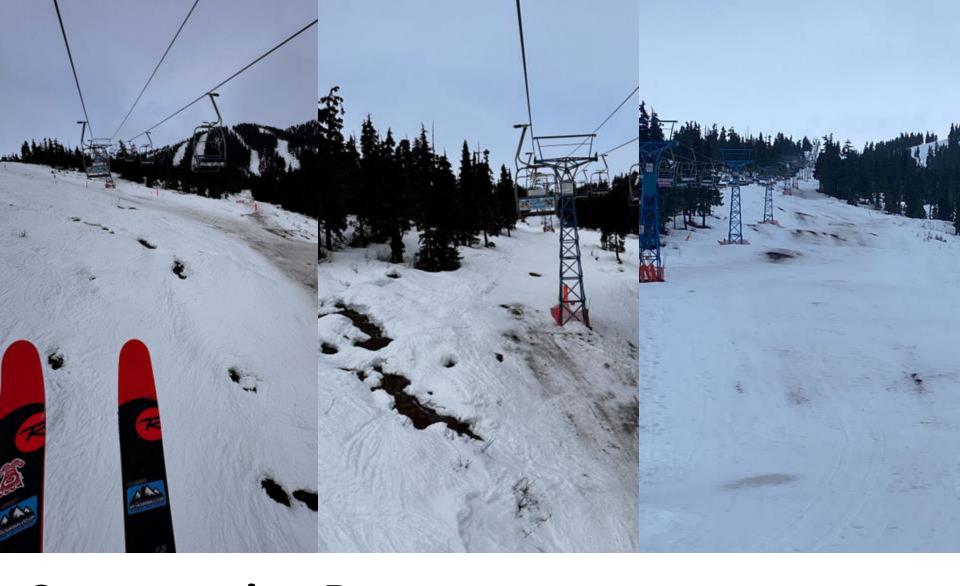

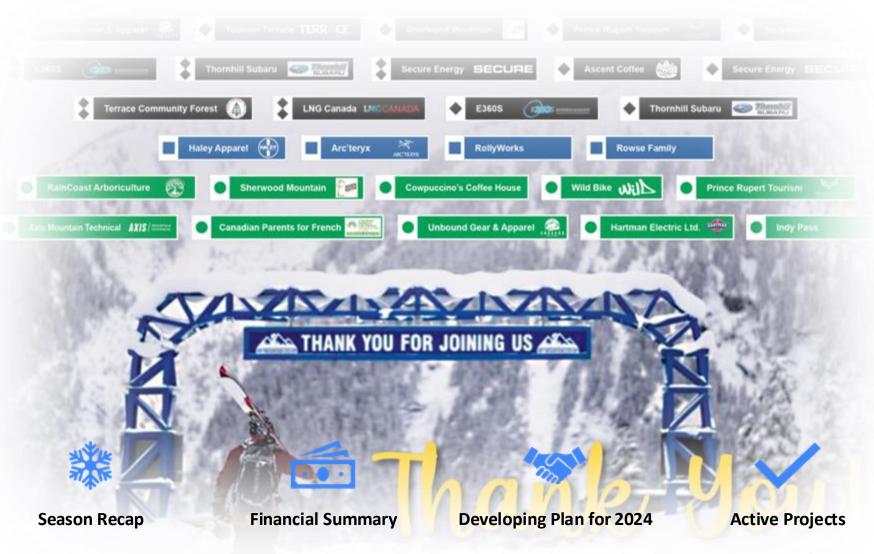

 - Address drainage issues



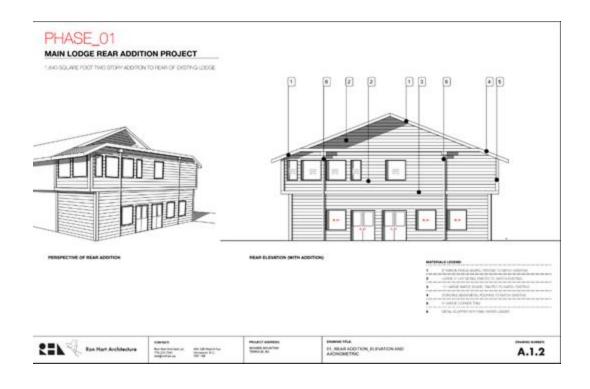

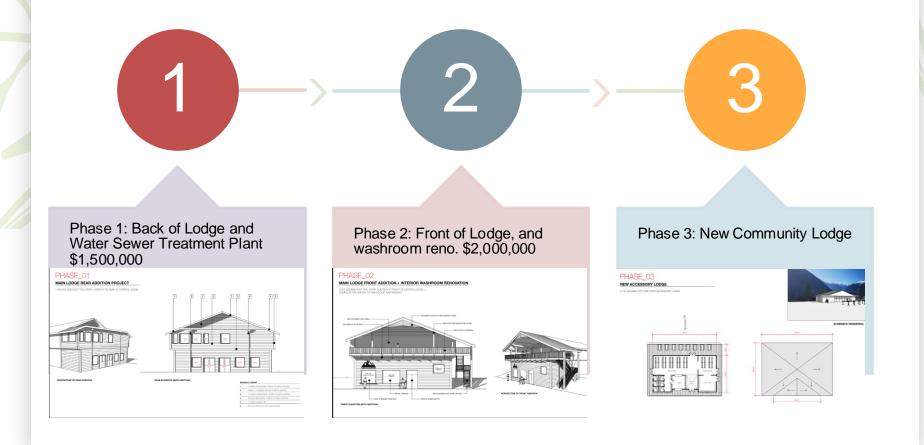
